Director's Note,

At its essence, Matilda, the Musical is about the intersection of childhood and adulthood. Matilda is a child with wisdom beyond her years, caught in circumstances beyond her control that surround her with adults that act more like children. Miss Honey is an adult, who's confidence and agency has been stunted by traumatic events from her childhood.

People often assume that childhood is left in childhood. Adults are expected to "get over" events from long ago, but this turns out to be a more herculean feat than quips on social media to just "grow up" would have us believe. Likewise, we often assume that children don't have anything to offer in terms of wisdom or insight. As life has taught me and Matilda does a brilliant job of illustrating, both of these assumptions are far from true.

With Matilda, Roald Dahl, author of children's books Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and James and the Giant Peach, in his signature dark and quirky style, has written another story for children that refuses to talk down to kids. Dahl excels in telling stories that children can appreciate for it's humor, fantasy elements and child protagonists, while dealing with very the realistic emotional and situational evils of the world.

It's this mixture of silliness and fantasy with honest reality that makes it an ideal musical to be performed by teenagers, who are themselves at a crossroads of childhood and adulthood. The cast and crew of Abilene High's production of Matilda, the Musical understand as well as anyone what it is like to feel adult like pressures, while still possessing childlike wonder and imagination. Having come through nearly two years of COVID and shutdowns these students have weathered much and have come through as resilient as ever, eager to display their talents and work ethic to the Abilene community.

My admiration for these students is great, and I can't wait for you to see the fruits of their hard work.
