



## **Audition Information**

Thank you for your interest in the Abilene High School's 2024-2025 musical, *Bright Star, School Edition*. This page contains information for those wishing to audition for a performance role.

Rehearsals will begin on **Tuesday**, **September 3**. The following is a list of important dates associated with the production.

Regular rehearsals will be **Monday-Friday**, **4-6pm**, after school. *Not all performers will* **be needed at every rehearsal**. You will receive a detailed schedule at the first rehearsal that will indicate when you are called, based on your character.

All rehearsal will be in the one of the following locations:

- Abilene High School Fine Arts Building
- Dance Discovery Studios (you will need transportation from school to the studio)

Students wishing to be cast be advised of the following:

- In order to remain in the cast a student **must maintain a passing average in all classes.** During the course of rehearsals eligibility will be checked every three weeks.
- Students will be expected to attend all rehearsals for which their character is called unless prior arrangements have been made. Failure to attend a rehearsal for which you did not previously list as a conflict, may result in recasting.
- Students will be expected to be responsible for memorizing lines by the date stated on the rehearsal schedule. Failure to do so may result in recasting.

## **AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Attend the information meeting in the Auditorium on Tuesday, August 20 from 4-5pm.
- Fill out a Conflict Sheet, Audition Packet, and Company Contract. Student and parent must sign and return to Mr. Martin or Mrs. Gonzales by **Friday, August 23.**
- Prepare a 32 measure (approx.) section of a song. Your selection should be less than a minute.
  - o The ideal selection would be a pop-country or bluegrass song in a style similar to the music in *Bright Star*. Listen to music from the musical (available on Spotify, AppleMusic, YouTube, etc.) to get a sense of the tone and style.

NOTE: This is different from years past. I would prefer a pop-country song over a song from Musical Theatre.

- o If you arrive without a prepared song, we will check your vocal range. You may not be eligible for a lead role without prepared material.
- Sign up for a 5-minute time slot for the morning of Saturday, 8/24
- Attend the dance auditions, at 3pm on 8/24 in the Abilene High Auditorium.
- Arrive early for your audition time. Late comers will be skipped and will be allowed to auditioned as time becomes available.
- Check the call board for call-backs, to be held Monday and Tuesday, 8/26-27 at 4pm.

## **Character Descriptions**

Alice Murphy – plays both 16-17 and 36-37. Alice at age 36-37 is an editor of a southern literary magazine; intelligent, attractive, professional – but with an air of melancholy. Young Alice at age 16-17 is rebellious, high-spirited, adventurous - looking to break out of small-town life and experience the world.

**Billy Cane** - a young soldier returning home from WWII; an aspiring young writer; fresh, open, optimistic, charming, and a little naïve.

Daddy Cane - Billy's father. A widower. Spry, good looking. Kind hearted, if a bit lonely.

**Margo Crawford** - a small-town bookstore owner; a childhood friend of Billy's who now harbors romantic feelings towards him; a natural beauty with a keen intellect

Max – a customer at Margo's bookstore, at first, he has a crush on Margo, but later becomes Edna's beau.

**Florence** - an employee at Margo's bookstore and a childhood friend of both Billy and Margo.

**Edna** – an employee at Margo's bookstore.

**Daryl Ames** - An assistant at a literary magazine. Funny, with a dry and officious sense of humor. Insecure, and perhaps a bit socially awkward, but endearing and innately likeable.

**Lucy Grant** - A junior editor at a literary magazine. An ambitious, professional young "modern" career woman of the 1940s. Strong, forthright and provocative with a sharp sense of humor.

**Mama Murphy** - Alice's mother. A caretaker to her family and her rural community. A warm, loving, sensible woman. Hardworking, with great inner strength and compassion.

**Daddy Murphy** - Alice's father; an authoritative and a stern disciplinarian; devoutly religious, hard-working, a poor but proud farmer.

**Mayor Josiah Dobbs** - the Mayor of Zebulon; a political and financial powerbroker - distinguished, an imposing and controlling presence; has a genuine interest in protecting his son's future and his family name, but in doing so, is ultimately pushed to a point of extreme and irrevocable cruelty.

**Jimmy Ray Dobbs** - plays both age 18-20 and 38-40. Jimmy Ray in his early 20s in flashbacks is Mayor Dobbs' son and young Alice's beau; handsome, boyishly charming,

well-built and intelligent; from a family of wealth and power and is being groomed by his father for a similar future in the family business; an independent thinker who is not afraid to stand up to his father for what he believes in; he has a sense of personal responsibility and morality as well as a deep reserve of passion and emotion.

**Stanford** – Loyal assistant to Mayor Josiah Dobbs.

**Ensemble** – Customers, bar patrons, towns folk, etc.
